



South Seminole Heights Civic Association (SSHCA) Beautification Award

What: South Seminole Heights Civic Association's Semi-Annual Beautification Award based on recent or continued improvements to a home/yard that make an observable and positive difference to the aesthetics of our community.

When: Spring & Fall of each year (one winner per season, two winners per year).

Eligibility: Limited to South Seminole Heights residences only (may only win once every 5 years).

Nomination: Nominations will be accepted via email to info@sshca.org. Residents can nominate a home in the South Seminole Heights neighborhood or may self-nominate as well.

Criteria: All judging is based on an exterior inspection of the nominated home:

1. Condition/Maintenance of exterior of home
2. Condition/Maintenance of landscaping and yard
3. Condition/Maintenance of walkways/driveway and site improvements (Fencing, Flags, Etc.)
4. Creativity, innovation and uniqueness of home
5. Overall curb appeal

Judges: The judges include the current SSHCA Board Members and the Beautification Chair. Judges shall narrow down the nomination list to 6 eligible homes per period, will provide a total score for all nominated homes and then choose the overall winner.

Notification: The SSHCA Beautification chair will notify all participants in writing if they are eligible and nominated for the award, when the judging will take place, when results will be announced. The winner receives a beautification award banner and is recognized in the upcoming newsletter.

Scoring: Judges utilize a 5 point scale (1-average, 2-above average, 3-good, 4-great, 5-excellent) top score wins. In the event of a tie the Beautification Chair will make final decision.
